Edwin van der Sar won the UCL in 1995 with Ajax and 2008 with Man United.

3. What nation shockingly defeated reigning champions France in the first game of the 2002 World Cup?

Senegal, who won 1-0.

4. Which player became the youngest-ever Premier League player in the 2022/23 season?

It was Ethan Nwaneri, who made his debut for Arsenal, aged 15 and 181 days

5. Who scored the opening goal in the 2012/13 Champions League final?

Mario Mandzukic netted the goal for Bayern Munich.

6. Alex Telles, Xherdan Shaqiri and Radja Nainggolan all played for which club?

They've all played for Inter Milan

7. How many games did Arsenal draw in their Invincible season in 2003/04?

Arsenal won 26, drew 12 and lost none

8. Who won a Champions League/European title first – Hamburg, Nottingham Forest or Aston Villa?

Forest did it first, in 1979

9. What year did this happen – Inter Milan won the Serie A, Chelsea won the FA Cup, Manchester City finished 14th and Liverpool beat Chelsea on penalties in the Champions League?
