It was Yaya Toure, from 2011 to 2015

5. Which team plays the Estadio de San Mames?

It's Athletic Club, also known as Athletic Bilbao

6. Who is the only player to have scored in a Manchester, Merseyside and Old Firm derby?

It's Andrei Kanchelskis

7. Which English club is this – Founded in 1863, Stadium capacity of 30,089, a single League Cup, and their record Premier League loss is 0-7?
