1. Which football club has a stand named after Sir Elton John?

It's Watford: the singer was the Hornets' chairman.

2. Which team has won the most league titles in Italy?

Juventus: they've lifted 36, some 16 more than second-placed Inter Milan.

3. Who was the top scorer at Euro 2008?

David Villa top-scored for victors Spain with four goals.

4. How many Champions League trophies have Real Madrid won?

Los Blancos have lifted Old Big Ears 15 times.

5. Which nation is the smallest in terms of population to have ever qualified for the World Cup?

Iceland qualified in 2018 with a population of around 350,000 at the time.

6. Which Ballon d'Or winner has played for Milan, Inter Milan, Real Madrid and Barcelona?

Ronaldo, who moved to Barca from PSV, headed to Inter, then Real, then Milan.

7. Toby Alderweireld, Christian Eriksen and Jan Vertonghen all played for which side, other than Tottenham?

All three of them played for Ajax.

8. How many English managers have won the Premier League?

The answer is zero: Howard Wilkinson last won a league in 1991.

9. Who is the Bundesliga's all time top scorer?

Gerd Muller, who has 365 goals.

10. Which transfer cost the most – Paul Pogba moving from Juventus to Manchester United in 2016, Romelu Lukaku transferring from Inter Milan to Chelsea in 2021 or Eden Hazard moving from Chelsea to Real Madrid in 2019?

It was Lukaku, he cost around £8 million more than Hazard and Pogba – at £97 million
